### RADIO WORKSHOPS

WMPH-FM is a Broadcast Learning Center of the Brandywine School District. The sole purpose of the radio station for the student is to gain technical experience, develop communication skills and learn about the broadcast industry.

Eligibility: Must be a student in 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades in good academic standing

### WHAT TO EXPECT FROM THE RADIO WORKSHOPS

Every **Wednesday from 7 – 8:30 PM**, the radio workshops are held in room 011 next door to the radio station. Each meeting consists of:

1. Discussion of radio news and industry briefs (sources: FCC, NAB, Radioink)
2. WMPH week in review
3. Workshop
  - a. Lesson
  - b. Breakout group exercises
  - c. Conclude with department meeting

There are two radio facilities at Mount Pleasant High School.

1. **School internet radio station** (*also broadcasts at 88.1 FM on school property only*) – Students may develop and host their own radio show

2. **School FM radio station** WMPH 91.7 FM – Students that pass the audition will receive a designated time after school on WMPH  
**LISTEN: 91.7 FM anywhere in Wilmington and tri-state area**
