RADIO WORKSHOPS ~ AWARDS PROGRAM

WMPH-FM RADIO AWARDS

The Awards Program at WMPH-FM is designed to motivate the performance of each student to achieve a higher standard of excellence. Self-initiative, team work and community service are encouraged in the award process.

AWARD CRITERIA

Awards are eligible only for participating students during the designated workshop period. Workshop attendance, attitude and creativity are factored in to the final judgments.

AWARD CATEGORIES

- *SCRIPT WRITING* – Best script; Write a 60 second announcement reflecting either community service, the Brandywine School District and WMPH-FM.
- *ANNOUNCING* – Best vocal performance on a pre-recorded radio spot (minimum of 30 seconds)
- *NEWS REPORTING* – Best newscast of gathering, editing and announcing the news (minimum of two minutes)
- *AUDIO EDITING* – Best non-linear editing project incorporating voice(s), background music and special effects

SPECIAL COMMENDATIONS

- *BEST ATTITUDE* – Positive outlook and willingness to help
- *BEST SENSE OF HUMOR* – Mature humor on the air
- *BEST SHOW CREATIVITY* – Creative performance on the radio
- *BEST VOCAL INFLECTION* – Tone of voice and pronunciation of words on the air

CANDIDATE SELECTION PROCESS

All projects submitted will be reviewed by the WMPH-FM Leadership Team for evaluation then final selection.

AWARD PRESENTATION CEREMONY

Awards winners and their projects will be posted on the WMPH-FM website. The high school principals of the Brandywine School District will be notified of the award winners. High Schools are encouraged to acknowledge the winners during their own end of the year awards ceremony. Winners receive either a certificate or trophy of their achievement.
